The country-wide mock drill on Wednesday will cover 244 'civil defence districts', mapped for housing sensitive installations such as nuclear plants, military bases, refineries and hydroelectric dams.

The exercise will assess real-time strategic emergency response to an impending threat of a retaliation to India's vow of hunting down Pakistanbased terrorists and their handlers for the massacre of 26 tourists in the Pahalgam attack on April 22.

Union Home Secretary Govind Mohan on Tuesday chaired a high level meeting with the Chief Secretaries and other top officials of the States and Union Territories to formalise the standard operating procedure of conducting the mock exercise, code named 'Operation Abhyaas' and happening for the first time after the 1971 war.

The meeting took place through video conference.

The State governments and UT administrations seeking the participation of the State Disaster Response Force and various district departments, including the police, civil defence wardens and volunteers, home guards (active as well as reservists), National Cadet Corps, National Service Scheme, Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan and students came up for discussion at the meeting.

Besides that, early camouflaging of vital plants and installations, cleaning of bunkers and trenches that mostly exist in large numbers in border districts.

The conduct of the exercise is planned up to the village level, to bolster civil defence till the last tier of governance, given that it is considered integral to the nation's passive defence strategy.

On the basis of threat perception, the MHA has clubbed all the civil defence districts into three categories in collaboration with the Ministry of Defence.

DISTRICT CATEGORIES Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, Surat and Vadodara, among a dozen cities, figure in category 1 civil defence districts. These are followed by 200 such districts which are comparatively less vulnerable such as Hyderabad, Ahmedabad, Jamnagar and North Goa, fall under the category 2. And, finally, around 40 like Pulwama, Aurangabad, and Ratnagiri come under category 3, as per the classifications done

by the MHA. Nineteen districts of UP, 13 of Gujarat, 5 of Madhya Pradesh and 3 of Karnataka will witness live mock drills like the rest of India on Wednesday. Meanwhile, PM Narendra Modi continued his parleys with security and military top brass, with NSA Ajit Doval meeting him over brewing tensions with Pakistan

### Kashmir's political class retreats from Pakistan outreach, post-attack


